


## Iñupiaq Matching

## Aḡviḡmiñ Niqit

### Did you know that?

For bowhead shares in Barrow:

- ◆ The *qīnaq*, *uati*, *itigrūgaaq*, and *aqikkaq* and the *tavsi* are part of the captain's share.
- ◆ *Ninīq* is distributed to the whaling crews and people who help butcher the whale.
- ◆ During the spring whale hunt, one *talīguq* is for the harpooner and the other is shared by the other whaling crews.
- ◆ During the fall hunt, the harpooner receives one *talīguq* and the other is shared by those helping to butcher the whale.
- ◆ One half of the *utchik* and the *suqqait* is for the captain, and the other half is shared by those helping to butcher the whale.
- ◆ The *tavsi*, plus other things, are served to the community the day after butchering is completed, and the *uati* is saved for feasts!
