Individual Travel

Individual Travel from Outside Alaska

Alaska Mandate #10 currently requires a 14 day quarantine for ALL PEOPLE coming into Alaska– including Alaska Residents

Effective March 25, 2020 to June 2, 2020 unless extended



- 14 day quarantine at destination
- Proceed directly from the airport to your designated quarantine location
- If you are a resident, your designated quarantine location is your residence.
Remain in your designated quarantine location for a period of 14 days or the duration of your stay in Alaska, whichever is shorter.
- You may leave your designated quarantine location only for medical emergencies or to seek medical care.
- Do not visit any public spaces, including stores, post office, or restaurant.
- Do not allow visitors in or out of your designated quarantine location other than authorized to enter the designated quarantine.
- Comply with all rules or protocols related to your quarantine
- If you are required to self-quarantine - social distancing guidelines APPLY.

Individual Travel Inside Alaska

Alaska Mandate #18: All Travel To Or From A Community Off The Road System Or The Marine Highway System Is Prohibited, Except As Necessary For:

Effective May 12, 2020 at 8:00 AM, and remains in effect until amended, superseded, or rescinded.

- Critical Personal Needs are critical to meeting a person's individual or family needs. Needs include buying, selling, or delivering groceries; getting fuel for vehicles or residential needs; transport family members for out-of-home care, essential health needs, or for purposes of child custody exchanges; receiving essential health care; providing essential health care to a family member; obtaining other important goods; and engaging in subsistence activities.
- Essential Services/Critical Infrastructure Workers who are subject to their company's Community Workforce Protective Plan
- Emergency First Responders, Law Enforcement within official duties, Office of Children's Services and Essential Government Services personnel needed to provide for health, safety and welfare of the public
- No one traveling to or from any community for Critical Personal Needs or Critical Infrastructure travel may be subject to any automatic quarantine or isolation on arrival, except as allowed under Alaska Statutes or Health Mandates.
