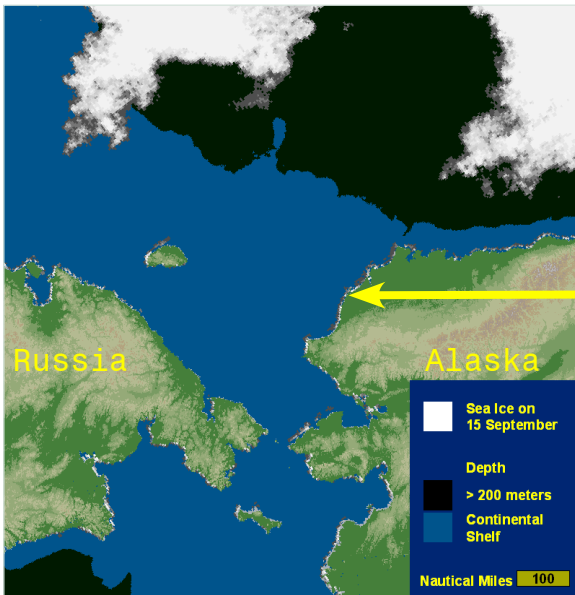


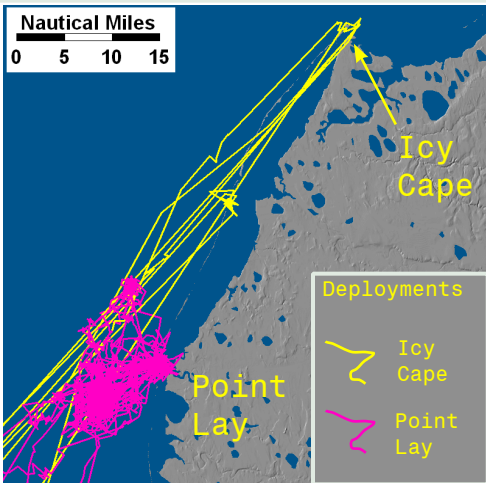
Walrus Movements, Autumn 2009



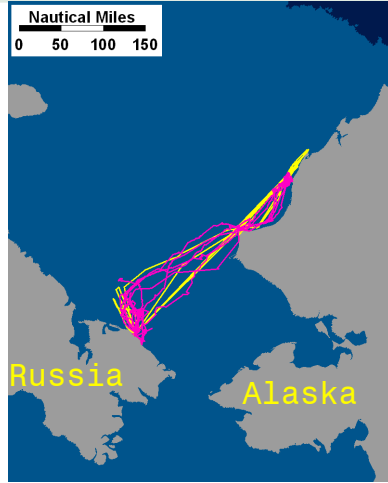
When sea ice retreated far north over deep waters, walrus came ashore in large numbers.



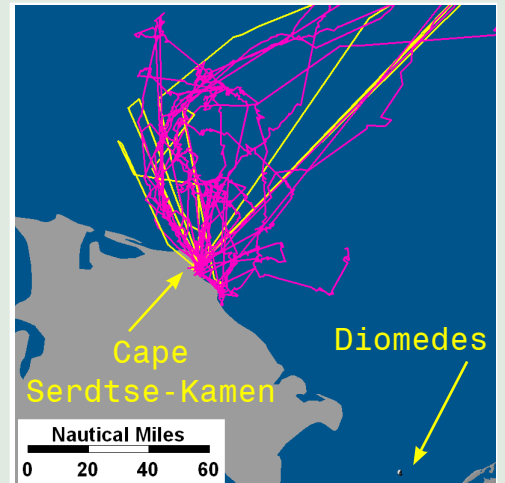
We tracked 15 walrus from beaches near Icy Cape and Point Lay with radio tags.
