Kid's Page Answers

Iñupiaq Matching:

Aglu = Under Mouth for Captain

Añirruq = For Whale Tail Feast after first ice or March

Avarraq = Flukes for 2nd day of Qagruq

Iñi = Lower Middle Crew, Harpooner

Niksiutaq = Blowhole for butcher crews

Qaa = Lower Lip and Tongue for 3rd, 4th boats

Qaġlu = Upper Lip for 5th, 6th boats

Qimiġluk = Upper Middle for Captain's Crew

Silvik = Bottom Middle for 1st, 2nd boats

Suluġaq = Part of Añirruq Distributed to all households

Suqqaich = Baleen ½ to captain, ½ to crew

Taliġuq = Flipper for Captain

Tavsiñaaq = Middle Belt portion for 7th, 8th boats

Tirraġiagruq = For fresh boiled Maktak to all boats

Tirraġiiq = Piece of Uati boiled and eaten on the ice

Uati = Behind Tavsiñaaq for Captain's share

What is it?

A = baleen and maamaq (or gums)

B = hair on nose (top of upper jaw) or rostrum

C = hairs and spots on chin patch

D = eye, turning white around it

E = Scars on whale, maybe polar bear claw marks

F = blowhole

G = fluke cross-sections or akkikak

H = whale lice
