



RIGHT-OF-WAY VEHICLE REMOVAL

If it is YOUR vehicle

- If you need help moving your vehicle for whatever reason, reach out to the Borough, and we'll do what we can to assist.

**Planning and Public Works assist villages without a zoning commission. Currently, only Utqiagvik has one.*

If it's NOT YOUR vehicle

- If there is a vehicle and it's in the Right-of-Way and it should be moved, inform the North Slope Borough **Planning Inspector (Leroy @907-302-8701)**.
- Inspectors will get the VIN number and provide it to the **Police** to identify the owner. They may also ask nearby residents about the vehicle's ownership.
- If the owner is unknown, inspectors will inform the resident to contact the City of Utqiagvik (COU) for the removal form, or inspectors can assist with this process. The COU enforces the 3-day notice for removal.*
- NSB does not remove vehicles that are not in the Right-of-Way. For these cases, work with the City of Utqiagvik.*

If a vehicle owner refuses to remove their vehicle from the Right-of-Way, inspectors will give them 2 weeks to 30 days before issuing a notice of violation, which includes a \$1500 per day fine.
